

MODALITIES OF PARTICIPATION IN THE CONGRESS

Keynote speakers

Academics, whose outstanding accomplishments in the field of Classical Studies and their tradition are internationally recognized, will be invited to participate in this modality with a 40 minutes-long individual conference.

Plenary tables

Special guests of wide recognition within the field of Classical Studies and their tradition will be also invited to participate in this modality. The theme of their individual conferences must be related to any of the seven modules or topics foreseen in the General Programme of the Congress. The maximum exposure time for each presentation will be 15 minutes long.

Thematic tables

All other individual proposals will be peer-reviewed and submitted to the Organizing Committee's approval and conformation. Once notified about their acceptance, they must fill out the register form and, according to the instructions, pay the \$200 USD inscription fee. Within this modality tables will be simultaneous and up to three speakers may participate in each one. Although a 12 minutes presentation will be allowed to each speaker, at the end of each table 10 minutes will be granted to interact with the audience and answer any possible questions.

Editorial exhibition

Publishers will be most welcome to participate during the Congress by displaying their publications and catalogues about different authors and themes related to Classical Studies upon registration in the corresponding [application form](#). Their participation will be free and will consist on a video with a maximum duration of 5 minutes, in MP4 format, in which the link to their electronic catalogue must be included, as well as any special offers, discounts or promotions they may provide to all participants in the congress. This video must be sent to the Congress' official mail [fiex_mexico2022@unam.mx](mailto:fiec_mexico2022@unam.mx) from August 30, 2021 up to January 31, 2022.

In order to support the participant publishers with the diffusion of their publications, all registered videos will be transmitted as informative "capsules" at different times during the whole week-long of the Congress, particularly between sessions of plenary and thematic tables.
